Rules and Regulations

- 1. Please keep all Rental documents with you while on camp property. You may need to present them to the Bible camp custodial staff during your stay at the Elbow Lutheran Bible Camp.
- 2. Check-in time is 2:00 PM. Check-out time is 11:00 AM. If you would like to renew the camp for additional nights, this must be done **prior to 10:00 AM on the day before** you are scheduled to depart.

- 3. Quiet time is from 11:00 PM through 8:00 AM.
- 5. A limit of six people per campsite is allowed, unless campers are members of the same immediate family.
- 6. The campground and campsites may only be used for their intended purpose and all visitors shall not act in any way in which they are a nuisance, annoyance or inconvenience to other occupants of the campground or the camp.
- 7. The renter recognizes that the campground forms part of a Christian ministry camp and agrees that the conduct of persons using the area shall at all times be in accordance with Christian principles, morals and philosophy. As this is a Lutheran Church Camp catering to children, young adults and families, the use of alcohol and tobacco is prohibited in all areas.
- 8. No pets allowed.
- 9. No fires are allowed except for in the Tee Pee. Firewood is provided.

- 10. All garbage, ashes and other refuse must be disposed of in the containers provided in the campground.
- 11. All camping units and vehicles must be licensed and kept on roadways or parking lots or within the campsite itself. Only one vehicle is allowed per campsite at any one time. All watercraft must be parked in the bible camp North Parking Lot or on the extreme east end of the campground.
- 13. Wildlife is present in and around the campground. Please DO NOT feed any wildlife and always maintain and leave your site clean.
- 14. Do not damage, destroy or remove any trees, seedlings or other vegetation within the campground or Bible camp property. Please respect the facilities, signs and amenities and report any damages to the Bible camp custodial staff immediately.
- 15. Campers are requested to use reasonable judgement in the use of water and electrical services, to minimize consumption costs, and not to exceed the capacity of the systems provided. The Bible camp may restrict the use of power within the campground, specifically the use of air conditioners, depending upon the number of campers and the draw on power. Please respect the posted restrictions or the request of the campground host, should this be necessary.
- 16. A Cleanup/Damage fee will be charged if the camp is left with garbage or damages upon departure. We expect the camp to be left in the same condition in which it was found.
- 17. While on our property, vehicles, accessories and contents are left at the owner's risk. Please be sure you vehicles and contents are properly insured.
